ON-SCENE INTERVIEWS – STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS

Student Instructions:

You are provided a scene where you will be interviewed.

- 1) Develop your character.
 - a. What physical characteristics might you have? Would you be young or older? Do you use a cane? Did you just burn your tongue on soup?
 - b. How do you speak? Do you have an accent?
 - c. What is your emotional state? Are you happy, sad, angry, depressed, serious, etc.?
- 2) Develop a conflict for your character.
 - a. Do you have a social or ethical conflict?
 - b. Do you have a phobia that is aggravated in this scene?
 - c. Do you have a physical or mental limitation?
- 3) Stay in character as you are being interviewed.

<u>Town Hall Meeting – Emotional Discussion</u>

You are at a Town Hall Meeting where a very emotional discussion is being held concerning what to build in the middle of the town square. You will participate at the meeting in a discussion with townspeople and local officials to decide what type of structure should go there. A moderator will lead the meeting.
